

City of Westbrook Cemeteries Memorial Regulations

To ensure compatibility with existing monumentation, the following rules and regulations for memorials are hereby adopted:

- Maximum dimension for one grave lot
Die : 2-0 x 0-6 x 2-0
Base: 2-6 x 1-0 x 0-8
 - Maximum dimension for two grave lot
Die : 2-6 x 0-8 x 2-4
Base: 3-2 x 1-2 x 0-8
 - Maximum dimension for three grave lot
Die : 3-0 x 0-8 x 2-6
Base: 3-10 x 1-2 x 0-8
 - Maximum dimension for four grave lot and larger
Die : 4-6 x 0-10 x 2-8
Base: 6-0 x 1-4 x 0-10
-
- All bases must be 8" thick
 - Minimum thickness of dies shall be 6 inches.
 - Monoliths are not allowed.
 - No colored etching, lithochrome, or other artificial coloring will be allowed.
 - All slant style markers must be on a base with a minimum thickness of 6 inches.
 - All bases must be the same color and type of stone as the die.
 - All flush markers on a family lot must be same color and type of stone as the upright monument. In the event that the original color is no longer available, the Cemetery board may authorize the use of a compatible color. Government markers are exempt from the requirements of this paragraph.
 - All memorials must have a concrete foundation under the base. The monument supplies shall order such foundations from the cemetery board on order forms supplied by the cemetery for this purpose.
 - As of March 1, 1995, Hickey or Bevel markers will not be allowed, except to match existing markers on family lots.
 - No Monuments shall be erected until the foundation is cured.
 - No monument, foundations, or other structures shall be placed, erected, or maintained on a City of Westbrook Municipal cemetery grave site unless done in full compliance with these regulations and these otherwise adopted by the trustees.

Failure to observe these regulations shall be bases for excluding non-conforming monument, foundations, memorial and other structures from said municipal cemeteries.

Monument companies, their agents, employees, together with the decedent, next of kin and agents there-of shall be jointly and severably liable for conforming with these regulations, as a condition precedent to placing monumentation upon Westbrook Municipal gravesites.
