#### Job Duties:

- Perform complex and a full range of operational and maintenance tasks necessary for the safe, efficient operation of the Wastewater Collection System Facilities.
- Inspect pumping station equipment and structures on a daily or periodic basis. Make needed adjustments.
- Operate valves, gates and pumps and monitor gauges, meters, alarms and panels to control and adjust pump station operation.
- Perform preventive maintenance on pump station equipment.
- Inspect sewer lines, manholes and regulating structures on a routine basis and correct operational problems.
- Operate sewer cleaning and inspection equipment, such as rodding machines, jet machines and camera equipment in a safe, efficient manner.

#### Qualifications:

- Graduation from an accredited high school or equivalent with at least 3 years experience in the Wastewater field.
- Possess a valid State of Maine Class B Driver's License with a Tank Vehicle Endorsement
- Mechanical abilities in the areas of pump station equipment, collection system repair and equipment maintenance.
- Ability to work and comprehend problems independently applying knowledge, judgement and tact.
- Must be physically able to complete necessary tasks while wearing an approved respirator.
